### **Relocation of the bus stop**

Following representations by TaWRA to Padstow Town Council at the suggestion of a local resident, the Council has agreed with the Police and the County Council that (subject to the agreement of the utility companies) the Windmill bus shelter will be moved. The Newquay to Padstow (556 service) bus shelter will be round the corner from its present site in Windmill so that those waiting for the bus are clearly visible to the driver. Also, on the other side of the road, we have requested consideration be given to a better and safer pulling-in and stopping place.
